FRAMED is a non profit organization offering monthly cultural events, combining a live music performance with an art exhibition. Offering a space for social and cultural interaction, we aim to bring together a community of artists, musicians and their audience in an engaging experience at an intimate setting. The musicians we invite – each acclaimed in their field, from jazz, classical and opera to electronic, singer-songwriters, world music and more – are paired with a presentation by an exceptional visual artist or artist collective with works including painting, photography, drawing, installation art and more.

In between Framed's monthly events, we are open as a Gallery during the day (Mo-Fr, 10:00-15:00), A space for all sorts of cultural events in the evening such as screenings, workshops, readings, artist talks, dancing classes, drawing classes and much more.

We also offer our unique and beautiful space for private events such as private dinners/screening/lectures/presentations and so on.

ABOUT THE SPACE

Located at the heart of Friedrichshain, Framed is a beautiful and cozy cultural salon. It counts with an equipped kitchen, a sound system (vinyl record player, surround sound system and a PA for concerts), a projector (very high screening quality). There are two sofas and a low seating area that can be used, as well as 100 chairs/stools and working tables if needed. The space can fit around 70 people (without tables) for lectures/concerts/presentations etc, and around 30-40 people for workshops/private dinner parties etc. Just send us your idea and we can arrange a private tour to see if our space can fit with your project.
